Lauded for her personal and engaging performances, with critics praising her "authentic and honest musical personality", violinist Belle Ting is quickly building an international career, performing with orchestras including the Polish Baltic Philharmonic, the National Taiwan Symphony Orchestra, Shanghai Symphony Orchestra, Cleveland Symphony Orchestra, Moscow State Philharmonic and the Odense Symphony Orchestra under conductors such as Lan Shui, Jahja Ling, Gabor Kali, Gerhard Schmalfluss, and Michael Stern.

Belle has performed at numerous festivals including the Verbier Festival in Switzerland and the International Kirishima Music Festival in Japan, and is prizewinner of over fifteen international competitions, including the International Thomas and Evon Cooper Violin Competition, the 24. International Johannes Brahms Competition, the International Isaac Stern Violin Competition and the 16th International Khachaturian Violin Competition, where she also won the popular vote for the Audience Award.

Born in Taipei, Belle began her musical studies at the age of seven in Canada and studies at the University of Music and Performing Arts in Vienna, where she was one of the youngest recipients of the university's CARSA Rising Star Award.

Her performances have been featured in numerous radio, television and digital broadcasts, including ORF "Licht ins Dunkel", IDAGIO, Classic FM and medici.tv: Her debut album "Impressions" was released by KNS Classical in 2021, dedicated to works of French Impressionist composers.

Belle is the founder of "Classics From the Other Side", an annual celebration of chamber music that brings together young musicians from Asia and Europe to connect cultures through musical collaboration.
